AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 82-2, THE COMPREHENSIVE ZONING REGULATIONS FOR THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF COLLIER COUNTY BY AMENDING SECTION 20 -DEFINITIONS BY CHANGING DENSITY, RESIDENTIAL TO ALLOW FOR ANY FRACTIONAL UNIT TO BE CONVERTED UPWARD IF 4 OR MORE OF A WHOLE UNIT, AND BY PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE:

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Collier County, Florida:

SECTION ONE:

Section 20 of the Zoning Ordinance of Collier County, Ordinance 82-2 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Density, Residential: The number of residential dwelling units permitted per gross acre of land and determined by dividing the number of units by the total area of land within the boundaries of a lot or parcel not including dedicated rights-of-way And except as otherwise provided for in this zoning In the determination of the number of . ordinance. residential dwelling units to be permitted on & specific parcel of land, a fractional unit shall-now entitle-the-applicant-to-an-additional-unit. shall be converted upward if 's or more of a whole unit, or downward if less than 's of a whole unit, to the nearest whole unit value.

SECTION TWO:

This Ordinance shall become effective upon notice that it has beenreceived by the Office of the Secretary of State.
