AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 82-2, THE COMPREHENSIVE ZONING REGULATIONS FOR THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF COLLIER COUNTY BY AMENDING SECTION 7.26 INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT BY ADDING ROADSIDE SALES AS A PERMITTED PRINCIPAL USE; AND BY PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE:
