AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 82-2, THE COMPRE-HENSIVE ZONING REGULATIONS FOR THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF COLLIER COUNTY BY AMENDING SECTION 8.11 & & 2) TO ALLOW FOR CONSUMPTION ON PREMISES ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE ESTABLISHMENTS IN SHOPPING CENTERS TO BE MEASURED FROM THE OUTER WALL OF SAID ESTABLISH-MENT AND BY PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE:

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Collier County, Florida:

SECTION ONE:

Section 8.11 a 1) & 2) of the Zoning Ordinance of Collier County, Ordinance 82-2 is hereby amended to read as follows:

(1) No such use shall be located within five hundred (500) feet of any established school, church, public park, or playground. This does not include beach access points.

The distance of five hundred (500) feet shall be measured as the shortest distance between the lot on which the school, church, public park or playground is located and the lot on which the alcoholic beverages are to be sold, except that establishments located in shopping centers shall be measured to the outer wall of the establishment.

(2) No such use shall be located within five hundred (500) feet of any existing establishment which sells alcoholic beverages for consumption on premises.

The distance of five hundred (500) feet shall be measured as the shortest distance between the lot on which the existing establishment is located and the lot on which the alcoholic beverages are be sold, except that establishments located in shopping centers shall be measured to the outer wall of the establishment.

SECTION TWO:

This Ordinance shall become effective upon notice that it has been received by the Office of the Secretary of State.
