AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 82-2, THE COMPREHENSIVE ZONING REGULATIONS FOR THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF COLLIER COUNTY BY AMENDING SECTION 13.1e, PROVISIONAL USES BY LIMITING REQUESTS FOR EXTENSION TO ONE (1) EXTENSION UP TO ONE (1) YEAR; AND BY PROVIDINAN EXTECTIVE DATE:

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Collier County, Florida:

SECTION ONE:

Section 13.1e of the Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended to read as follows:

13.1 e. Conditions and Safeguards: In recommending approval of any provisional use, the Planning Commission may also recommend appropriate conditions and safeguards in conformity with this Zoning Ordinance. Violation of such conditions and safeguards which are made a part of the terms under which the provisional use is granted, shall be deemed a violation of this Zoning Ordinance.

Any provisional use shall expire one (1) year from the date of grant, unless-appealed-and-extended-by-action-of-the Beard-sf-Sening-Appeals, if by that date the use for which the provisional use was granted has not been commenced; and a provisional use shall expire one (1) year following the discontinuance of the use for which the provisional use was granted if the use has not then been commenced.

The Board of Zoning Appeals may extend a provisional use one time for up to one (1) year upon written request of the peritioner. This extension must be requested and approved prior to expiration of the original provisional use.

SECTION TWO:

This Ordinance shall become effective upon receipt of notice that I it has been filed with the Secretary of State.
