AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 82-2, THE COMPREHENSIVE ZONING REGULATIONS FOR THE UNIN-CORPORATED AREA OF COLLIER COUNTY BY AMENDING SECTION 20 - DEFINITION OF ACCESSORY USE OR STRUCTURE BY ADDING RESTAURANT AND BOWLING ALLEYS TO THE LIST OF USES FOR WHICH THE SERVICE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IS AN ACCESSORY USE: AND BY PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE:

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Collier County, Florida:

SECTION ONE:

Section 20 of the Zoning Ordinance is hereby comessled to read as follows:

Accessory Use or Structure: A use or a structure of a nature customarily incidental and subordinate to the principle use or structure and, unless otherwise provided, on the same premises. On the same premises with respect to accessory uses and structures shall be construed as meaning on the same -lot or on a contiguous lot in the same ownership. Where a building is attached to the principal building, it shall be considered a part thereof, and not an accessory building. A facility for the service of malt, vinous, or other alcoholic beverages shall be deemed an accessory use for a movel, hotel, boatel, private club, country club, yacht club, restaurant, bowling alleys, or golf club provided all other applicable requirements of State law and County regulations are met.

SECTION TWO:

This Ordinance shall become effective upon notice that it has been received by the Secretary of State.
