

ORDINANCE 84- 4

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 82-2, THE COMPREHENSIVE ZONING REGULATIONS FOR THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF COLLIER COUNTY, FLORIDA, BY AMENDING SECTION 7.16 b 3 (r) BY ADDING TRAVEL TRAILERS AS A PROVISIONAL USE IN THE VR-VILLAGE RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF COLLIER COUNTY, FLORIDA:

SECTION ONE:

Section 7.16 b 3 (r) of the Zoning Ordinance of Collier County, Ordinance 82-2, is hereby amended to read as follows:

7.16 b 3 (r) Tailor shops, taxidermists; tile sales
- ceramic tile; tobacco shops, toy shops;
travel trailers and tropical fish stores.

SECTION TWO:

This Ordinance shall become effective upon notice that it has been received by the Office of the Secretary of State.
