SECTION ONE:

Section 8.31 of the Zoning Ordinance of Collier County, Ordinance 82-2 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Any political sign erected on private property within 300 fee: of a designated polling site must be removed prior to 7:00 A.N. on the day of any election for which the candidate or issue mentioned or referenced to on said sign appears on the ballot.
