## SECTION ONE:

Section 7.7 (b)(3) (n) of Ordinance 82-2, the Zoning Ordinance of Collier County, Florida is hereby smended to read as follows:

(n) Private clubs and yacht clubs and related facilities of a non-commercial nature, such as boat ramps, docks, restaurant, cocktail lounge and limited overnight lodging rooms units for persons arriving by yacht and docking at the club, provided such facilities are used exclusively by the members of the club and their invitees and further provided that the total number of overnight lodging units is limited to no more than 15% of the number of total docks available.
