WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Collier County Planning Commission that aquaculture and mariculture are permitted provisional uses in the A-l Zoning District but are not permitted principal or provisional uses in the A-2 Zoning District; and

WHEREAS, The Collier County Planning Commission determined that aquaculture and mariculture were inadvertently omitted as permitted provisional uses in the A-2 Zoning District; and

WHEREAS, on January 16, 1986, the Collier County Planning Commission recommended that the Board of County Commissioners amend Ordinance 82-2, the Comprehensive Zoning Regulations for the Unincorporated Area of Collier County, Florida, by adding item "m" under Section 7.9.b.3. to allow squaculture and mariculture;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF COLLIER COUNTY, FLORIDA:

## SECTION ONE:

Section 7.9.b.3) of Ordinance 82-2, the Comprehensive Zoning Regulations for the Unincorporated Area of Collier County, Florida, shall be amended to add item "m" as follows:

- 3) Permitted Provisional Uses and Structures:
  - (a) Extraction and related processing and production.
  - (b) Earth mining and related processing.
  - (c) Churches and places of worship.
  - (d) Private landing strips for general aviation.
  - (e) Sawmills, provided that no sawmill shall be located closer than 1,000 feet from any County, State, Federal property or highway right-of-way.
  - (f) Cemeteries.
  - (g) Sport race tracks and arenas.
  - (h) Zoo, aquarium, aviary, botanical garden, or other similar use.
  - (1) Communication towers, provided that no communication tower shall be located closer than one-half (1) the height of the tower plus ten (10) feet from any County, State or Federal property or highway right-of-way.

- (j) Public, private and parochial school or college having a conventional academic curriculum. (See Section 8.11).
- (k) Hunting cabin, subject to all building codes and permits.
- (1) Child care centers.
- (m) Aquaculture and mariculture.
