AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 82-2, THE COMPREHENSIVE ZONING REGULATIONS FOR THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF COLLIER COUNTY, FLORIDA, BY DELETING SECTION 7.10, E - ESTATES DISTRICT, SUBSECTION b.2 (f) ALLOWING A MOBILE HOME, MOTOR HOME OR TRAVEL TRAILER AS A TEMPORARY RESIDENCE IN THE ESTATE DISTRICT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Collier County, Floriday determined that the provision allowing mobile homes, motor homes and travel trailers as temporary residences in the E - Estate District is not consistent with the semi-rural residential intent of the Estate district; and

WHEREAS, on June 4, 1985, the Board of County Commissioners placed a moratorium on permitting a mobile home, motor home or travel trailer as a temporary residence in the B - Estate District; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners directed staff to prepare an Ordinance to delete the provision allowing a mobile home, motor home or travel trailer as a temporary residence in the E - Estates District.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Collier County, Florida:

SECTION ONE:

Section 7.10 b.2.(f) of Ordinance 82-2, the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of Collier County, Florida is hereby deleted as follows:

(f)- Nobile-home,-motor-home-or-travel-trailer,-as-a temporary-residence-while-permanent-residence-is being-constructed,

Upon-issuance-of-a-building-permit-for-the construction-of-a-permanent-residence; the Board-of-County-Commissioners-may-approve-a permit-for-the-temporary-use-of-a-mobile-home; motor-home-or-travel-trailer-while-the permanent-residence-is-being-constructed;

The-duration-of-such-permit-shall-be-for-a maximum-period-of-six-(6)-months-or-upon completion-of-the-permanent-residence-for-which the-building-permit-was-issuedy-whichever-occurs firsty

The-temporary-permit-may-be-extended-by-the Board-of-Gounty-Gommissioners-upon-request-of the-permitted-two-(2)-times-for-a-period-of time-not-greater-than-three-(3)-months-for-each extension---Prior-to-approving-a-permit-for-the temporary-use-of-a-mobile-home-motor-home-or travel-trailery-the-Board-of-Gounty-Gommissioners-shall-take-the-following-factors into-consideration+

- (a) The location is sufficiently remote to justify a temporary residence on the property in order to prevent locting or damage to the permanent residence being constructed.
