WHEREAS, Ordinance 82-2, the Comprehensive Zoning Regulations for the Unincorporated Area of Collier County defines night clubs as "a restaurant, dining room, bar, or other similar establishment, providing food or refreshments, wherein paid floor shows or other forms of paid entertainment are provided for customers as a part of the commercial enterprise"; and

WHEREAS, the definition of night club needs clarification; and ...
WHEREAS, night clubs are defined by the Zoning Ordinance but not listed as a use in any district; and

WHEREAS, night clubs as a use should be permitted in the appropriate zoning district as a principal or provisional use; and

WHEREAS, the C-3, Commercial Intermediate district permits uses of similar character as a night club as a provisional use which provides for a use that would not be appropriate generally or without restriction throughout a particular zoning district but which, if controlled as to number, area, location, or relation to the neighborhood, would promote the public health, safety, welfare, morals, order, comfort, convenience, appearance, prosperity, or the general welfare; and

WHEREAS, the C-4, Commercial General, and the C-5, Commercial Industrial, districts permit uses of similar character as a night club such as restaurants and cocktail lounges;

NOW, TEEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Collier County, Plorida:

### SECTION ONE:

(m) New car dealership - outside display permitted, news stores, night clubs. (See Section 8.11).

## SECTION THREE:

Collier County Ordinance 82-2, Section 7.24, C-5 Commercial
Industrial District, Subsection 7.24 b.1)(m) shall be amended as follows:

(m) New car dealerships - outside display permitted; news stores; night clubs. (See Section 8.11).

## SECTION FOUR:

Collier County Ordinance 82-2, Section 20, Definitions, Club, Night, shall be amended as follows:

Club, Night: A restaurant, dining room, discotheque, bar or other similar establishment providing food or refreshments, wherein peid floor-shows-or-other-form-of-peid entertainment and/or live music such as bands, floor shows or similar forms of entertainment are provided for customers as a part of and attraction to the commercial enterprise.
