WHEREAS, Ordinance 84-5 omitted, in reference to "permitted use", the word "principal" which is required for clarification;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Collier County, Florida:

SECTION ONE:

Marie Control

Ordinance 82-2, Section 8.33, Fences, Subsection 8.33 a.5) shall be amended as follows:

Fences and wall shall be permitted principal uses in all residential districts; however as a principal use, a fence or wall shall not, in any way, constitute a use or structure, which permits, requires and/or provides for any accessory use(s) and/or structure(s).

SECTION TWO:

Ordinance 82-2, Section 8.33, Fences, Subsection 8.33 b.6) shall be smended as follows:

Fences shall be permitted principal uses in s11 non-residential districts; however as a princ 'al use, a fence or wall shall not, in any way, constitute a use or structure, which permits, requires and/or provides for any accessory uses(s) and/or structure(s).

SECTION THREE:
