Collier County Ordinance 82-2, Section 7.23, C-4 Commercial General, Subsection 7.23.b.1) Permitted Principal Uses and Structures) shall be amended as follows:

> Electrical supply stores; equipment _entals, including lawn mowers and power saws, which may include their repair and sale.

SECTION TWO:

This Ordinance shall become effective upon notice that it has been received by the Office of the Secretary of State.
