AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 82-2, THE COMPREHENSIVE ZONING REGULATIONS FOR THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF COLLIER COUNTY BY AMENDING SECTION 9.8, AUTOMOBILE SERVICE STATIONS, SUBSECTION b.17) TO INCREASE THE TIME PERIOD, FROM FORTY-FIVE (45) DAYS TO NINETY (90) DAYS, FOR TEMPORARY STORAGE OF VEHICLES; AND BY PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Collier County, Florida:

SECTION ONE:

Collier County Ordinance 82-2 Section 9.8 Automobile Service Stations, Subsection b.17) shall be amended as follows:

- 17) The temporary storage of vehicles shall be permitted if the vehicles are to be serviced at the service station or if the vehicles have been towed by the service station and are being held for servicing, for an insurance company, or for the sale or salvage. Any such vehicle(s), other than those vehicles serviced daily, shall be stored within an area surrounded by an opaque fence not less than six (6) feet high. Said vehicles shall not be stored longer than forty-five ninety (90) days.

SECTION TWO:

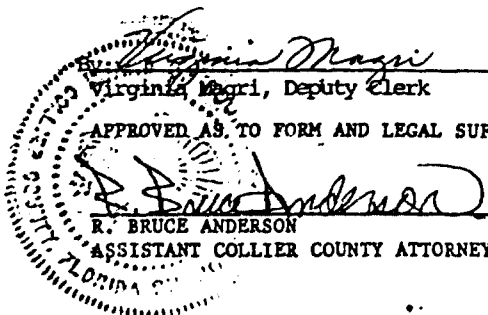
This Ordinance shall become effective upon notice that it has been received by the Office of the Secretary of State.
