AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 82-2, THE COMPREHENSIVE ZONING REGULATIONS FOR THE SHINCORPORATED AREA OF COLLIER COUNTY BY AMENDING SECTION 20, DEFINITIONS, BY DELETING THE LEFINITIONS: OFFICE, BUSINESS; OFFICE, GENERAL FILE, PROFESSIONAL; AND CLINIC, MEDICAL OR MEDICAL OFFICE; BY PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT AND SEVERABILITY; AND BY PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on January 5, 1982, the Board of County Commissioners approved Ordinance Number 82-2, which established the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance for Unincorporated Collier County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, Alan Reynolds representing Wilson, Miller, Barton & Peck Theorporated, petitioned the Board of County Commissioners of Collier County, Florida, to amend Ordinance Number 82-2 by deleting the definitions: Office, Business; Office, General; Office, Professional; and Clinic, Medical or Dental; and adding the definitions Office and Medical Office.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County
Commissioners of Collier County, Florida:

SECTION ONE: Amendments to Section 20, Definitions, of Ordinance 82-2, as amended.

Section 20, Definitions, of Ordinance 82-2, the Zoning
Ordinance of Collier County, Florida is hereby amended to read as
Follows:

Office,-Business:--An-office-for-such-activities-as-real estate-agencies,-advertising-agencies-(but-not-sign-shop); insurance-agencies,-travel-agencies-and-ticket-sales,-chamber of-commerce,-credit-bureau-(but-not-finance-company);-abstract and-title-agencies-or-insurance-companies,-stockbroker,-and the-like,---It-is-characteristic-of-a-business-office-that retail-or-wholesale-goods-are-not-shown-to-or-delivered-from the-premises-to-a-customer,--A-barber-or-beauty-shop-is-not-a business-office,

Office,-General:--An-office-for-the-use-of-either-uOffice, Businessu-or-uOffice,-Professionalu-purposes

Office,-Professional:--An-office-for-the-use-of-a-person-or persons-generally-classified-as-professionals,-such-as architects,-engineers,-attorneys,-accountants,-doctors, lawyers,-dentists,-psychiatrists,-psychologists,-and-the-like,

Elinic,-medical-or-dental:--an-establishment-where-human patients-who-are-not-lodged-overnight-are-admitted-for examination-and-treatment-by-one-person-or-a-group-of-persons practicing-any-form-of-the-healing-arts,-whether-such-persons be-medical-doctors,-chiropractors,-osteopaths,-chiropodists, naturopaths,-optometrists,-dentists,-or-any-such-profession, the-practice-of-which-is-regulated-by-the-state-of-Florida:--A

public-clinic-is-one-operated-by-any-governmental-organization for-the-benefit-of-the-general-public---All-other-clinics-ure private-clinics-

Office: A building or a portion of a building wherein services are performed involving predominantly administrative, professional or clerical operations. It is a characteristic that retail or wholesale goods are not shown to customers or delivered from the premises to a customer.

Medical Office/Clinic: Office space utilized for administering human medical and health related services, including outpatient clinics incidental to such offices. Medical office uses shall include medical doctors, dentists, psychiatrists, optometrists, osteopaths, chiropractors, naturopaths, nurse practitioners, health maintenance organizations and similar professional and group practices, which are regulated by the State of Florida.

SECTION TWO: Conflict and Severability

In the event this Ordinance conflicts with any other Ordinance of Collier County and other applicable law, the more restrictive shall apply. If any phrase or portion of the Ordinance is held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the tremaining portion.

SECTION THREE: Effective Date

This Ordinance shall become effective upon receipt of notice from the Secretary of State that this Ordinance has been filed with the Secretary of State.
