AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 76-30 THE COMPREHENSIVE ZONING REGULATIONS FOR THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF THE COASTAL AREA PLANNING DISTRICT BY AMENDING SECTION 29 MOBILE HOME PENTAL PARK DISTRICT BY CHANGING THE WORD "MAY" TO "SHALL" IN PARAGRAPH AND BY AMENDING PARAGRAPH 5-MINIMUM LOTTER REQUIREMENTS AND BY PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Planning Department petitioned the Board of County Commissioners to amend the Zoning Ordinance 76-30 as herein described;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Collier County, Florida:

SECTION ONE:

The Zoning Ordinance 76-30 is hereby amended and Section 29-Mobile Home Rental Park District is hereby amended accordingly as herein described:

AMEND PARAGRAPH 1 AS FOLLOWS: FROM:

District Purpose: The provisions of this district are Intended to apply to managed mobile home rental parks in which lots may not be sold to individuals and onsite management is provided.

TO:

District Purpose: The provisions of this district are intended to apply to managed mobile home rental parks in which lots shall not be sold to individuals and onsite management is provided.

AMEND PARAGRAPH 5-MINIMUM LOT REQUIREMENTS BY AMENDING SUBPARAGRAPH B AS FOLLOWS AND BY ADDING A NEW SUBPARAGRAPH G TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

- 5B. Depth of Side Yard Five (5) feet of Zero (0) foot setback. SEE PARAGRAPH G.
- 5G. The Zero (0) setback may be used on adjoining bets where carports are connected at a common lot like. In the case of the Zero setback, a minimum of ten (10) feet shall be required on the opposide size yard.

SECTION TWO:

This Ordinance shall become effective upon notice that it has been received by the Secretary of State.
