AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CRDINANCE 76-30 THE COMPREHENSIVE ZONING REGULATIONS FOR THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF THE COASTAL AREA PLANNING DISTRICT BY AMENDING SECTION 38-"E" ESTATES DISTRICT BY ADDING A NEW SUB-PARAGRAPH B TO PARAGRAPH 10-NONCONFORMING LOTS OF RECORD AND BY PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Zoning Department petitioned the Board of County Commissioners to amend the Zoning Ordinance 76-30 as herein described;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County E Commissioners of Collier County, Florida:

The Zoning Ordinance 76-30 is hereby amended and Section 38-Estates District, Paragraph 10 is hereby amended accordingly

as herein described:

AMEND PARAGRAPH 10 BY ADDING A NEW SUBPARAGRAPH B OR REAL

B. Non-Conforming Lots of Record on the Corner of two (25)
County Streets: Any non-conforming corner lot of record which abuts two (2) County streets shall have the fight yard with the longest street frontage setback a minimum of twenty-five (25) feet from the easement or right-of tay line. The front yard with the shortest street frontage shall require the 75' front yard setback.
