ORDINANCE - 80 - 79

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 76-30, SECTION 41, PLANNING COMMISSION: POWERS AND DUTIES UNDER ZONING ORDINANCE, PARAGRAPH 3, B, (4), (a) AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Coastal Area Planning Commission has recommended to the Board of County Commissioners of Collier County, Florida to amend the Zoning Regulations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Collier County, Florida:

SECTION ONE:

The Zoning Ordinance 76-30 hereby is amended as follows:

1. Amend Ordinance 76-30, Section 41, Board of Zoning Appeals: Powers and Duties Under Zoning Ordinance, Paragraph 3, B, (4), (a) to read as follows:

- (a) Special conditions and circumstances exist which are peculiar to the location, size, and characteristics of the land, structure, or building involved and which are not applicable to the same degree or extent to the lands, structures, or buildings in the same zoning district;

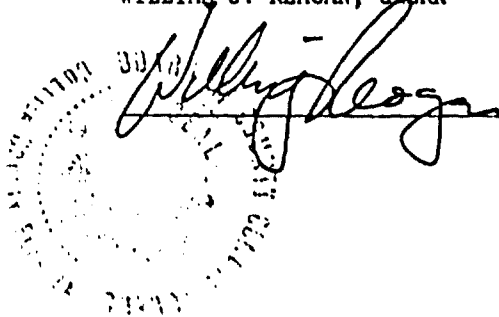
SECTION TWO:
