

- **Two** of the following items:
 - A deed, mortgage, monthly mortgage statement, mortgage payment booklet or residential rental or lease agreement. (Copies of deeds can be found on the Collier County Property Appraiser website <https://www.collierappraiser.com/>)
 - A utility hookup or work order that is not more than 2 months old.
 - A utility bill that is not more than 2 months old.
 - Mail from a bank or other financial institution, including checking, savings, or investment account statements, that is not more than 2 months old.
 - Mail from a government agency that is not more than 2 months old. (Mail from a government agency can include tax bills showing a Florida address. Tax bills can be found on the Collier County Property Appraiser website <https://www.collierappraiser.com/>)
 - One of the above items from the individual's parent, step-parent, legal guardian or other person with whom the individual resides and a statement from the parent, step-parent, legal guardian or other person with whom the person resides stating that the person does resides with him or her.

Please note, the above residency requirements do **NOT** apply to health care providers or individuals presenting for their second dose of the COVID-19 vaccine.
