DOH-Collier COVID-19 Vaccine Shipment Delay

Naples, Fla. — Due to the winter weather in parts of the country, there is a delay in the shipment COVID-19 Vaccine, including second doses. The Florida Department of Health in Collier County (DOH-Collier) should have an update over the next several days. Once we have confirmation of the incoming doses arriving, DOH-Collier will notify residents to schedule an appointment.

Per CDC Guidelines, the second dose of both the Pfizer and of the Moderna vaccine may be administered up to 6 weeks (42 days) after the first dose.
