

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS - Water Heater Replacement

PRWH

1&2 Family, Multi-Family and Commercial

Self-Issuing Permit

If all criteria are met, this is a self-issuing permit on the portal. If not, the permit will go through the traditional permitting process. Additional documents may be required.

Criteria for Permit Review:

- Changing type of water heater (electric to gas / tank to tankless / etc)
- Changing size of water heater
- Moving location of water heater
- If owner-builder
- If commercial

General Requirements for Permit Review

All submittal requirements must have documents completed and submitted for review.

• Application Form: Building Permit Application

Changing TYPE or SIZE of water heater:

• Plumbing Plans: Information about new water heater

Moving location of water heater

• Plumbing Plans: Floor plan showing existing and proposed water heater location

If owner-builder:

 Owner-Builder Affidavit: For owners of property when acting as their own contractor and providing direct, onsite supervision themselves of all work not performed by licensed contractors. Document must be signed in person and notarized by Collier County Growth Management staff.

If commercial:

• Plumbing Plans: Plans showing location of water heater and information about water heater
